



On November 20, 2017, the Primate of the Armenian Diocese in Georgia, His Grace Bishop Vazgen Mirzakhanyan toured Samtskhe-Javakheti and Tsalka's General Prelacy of the Armenian Diocese in Georgia. The Diocesan Primate was accompanied by the councilor at the RA Embassy in Georgia, Artak Grabsky; Head of the Financial Affairs of the Diocese Margarita Kirakosyan; and Director of the Administrative Department of the Diocese, Karen Yeritsyan.
