



The anniversary of the release of St. Gregory the Illuminator from the Khor Virap prison, the International Day of Children's Protection and Anniversary of Satkha Heroic Resistance of 1918 was marked in Javakheti.

On 1 June, at Surb Khach Church in Akhalkalaki a festive liturgy, dedicated to the release of St. Gregory the Illuminator from the Khor Virap prison, was served. Priest Tatev Marukyan conducted the divine service.

Vicar-General of Javakhek Supreme Archimandrite Babken Salbiyan congratulated the believers on the occasion of the holiday and urged to stand firm in the Christian faith.
