



Long ago an idea to construct and altar of Surb Astvatsatsin Church, built in Shahumyan village of Marneuli region in 1844, came up to a residing in Armenia sculptor Andranik Sargsyan.

So, on the 21st of June, 2013, the church-loving artist realized and old dream. A perfect sculpture carved from pink

Armenian tuff and marble – the magnificent Sacred Table was placed on the altar by equally skilled hands . Spiritual shepherd of the Armenian communities in Marneuli region Priest Movses Ashuryan and hard-working young people of the community helped and supported the sculptor in this matter.

In connection with this joyous occasion the Head of the Diocese of the Armenian Apostolic Church in Georgia, His Grace Bishop Vazgen Mirzakhanyan together with the representatives of the residence of the Diocese and the “Hayartun” Center arrived from Tbilisi to the village, and blessed the sculptor Andranik Sargsyan.

The excitement in the community was notable. Many people in the early morning went to the church to see the beautiful altar with a stunning image of the Holy Virgin Mary.

The Head of the Diocese accompanied by a retinue on the same day visited another temple, which in the Soviet era was turned into a house of culture
